


Reusing Bottles


How to Clean, Rinse, and Reuse Bottles

The COVID-19 global crisis has put an extraordinary strain on our supply chain in many ways, one you can control is your bottles. Expand your possibilities in using disinfectant, hand soap and hand sanitizer. Just save, clean and re-use your quart bottles, trigger sprayers and your pump bottles!


There are two important things to follow before you start cleaning your trigger sprayers and pump bottles:


- Ensure your bottle is completely empty to avoid wasting product.
- Wear the proper PPE based on the product that was last in the bottle.







1. Separate the trigger / pump with the attached tube from the bottle. Rinse each of them under warm water.





2. Fill a container with warm water and immerse the tube part of the trigger / pump. Use a separate container to immerse the bottle in warm water.





3. Squeeze the trigger / pump to flush product from the head. Make sure the nozzle is directed towards a sink. Continue spraying / pumping until warm water does not show any discoloration (15-20 sprays / pumps). If trigger is being switched between incompatible products, spray for at least two minutes.

Fill up bottle with warm water, shake side to side, and pour water into the sink. Continue this process until warm water does not show any discoloration.
